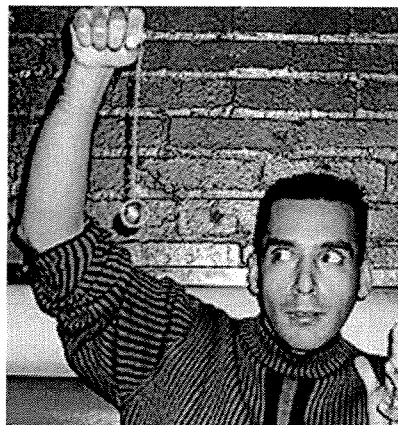
"Love does not equal a relationship," he explains. "In order to have a relationship, that love has to be reciprocated."
